- * Oversee asset recovery program that will maximize return on investment of overstocks, closeouts, salvage, withdrawn, surplus, discontinued and obsolete inventory by streamlining the returns process. Evaluate and assess the re-marketability of requested items whether through warranty credits, redeployment into service inventories or resale to secondary markets.
- * Monitor Physical Return Handling - Facility management, processing of physical returns including outdated, damages, withdrawals and discontinued product, product retrieval, reverse to forward fulfillment, facility auditing, repacking and kitting.
- * Minimizing cost associated with returns management through development of end to end solutions from return authorization to final disposition.
- * Development of policies and procedures to prevent returns. Identify inventory management buying and selling practices that drive up excess/obsolescence.
- * Monitor Return Material Authorization (RMA) to ensure timely returns and credits are accounted for.
- * For higher valued defective products, will evaluate repair and refurbishment initiatives so products can be re-used and re-marketed.
- * Generate detailed analysis reports to be presented to senior management to track trends and progress on current reverse logistics initiatives.
